PASS THAT OPIUM PIPE AROUND AGAIN, MR. MATSUMOTO.

TOKYO IS ALL UPSET ABOUT WHAT IT CALLS ARGENTINA'S "DOWNFALL". IT CLAIMS THAT THE U.S. TURNED THE HEAT ON TO MAKE IT A "VASSAL STATE" AND THAT THE SON'S OF HEAVEN MUST TURN THE MAILED FIST AGAINDT THE YANKS' "GREED AND

LUST".

AMERICAN FORCES CONTINUE TO ADVANCE IN CEBU, IN THE PHILLIPINES. U.S. FIGHTER BOMBERS DESTROYED 9 OUT OF 20 JAP PLANES ALONG THE CHINA COAST.

IN BURMS, THE BATTLE IS SEE-SAWING.

ON THE WESTERN FRONT, CANADIAN FORCES HAVE ENCOUNTERED HEAVY OPPOSITION

WHILE THE OTHER ALLIED ARMIES SEEM TO BE ROLLING AHEAD AT WILL.

1300 HEAVY BOMBERS AND 700 FIGHTERS HIT BRUNSWICK AND BRANDENBERG.

TOOK PLACE, AND IF THEY DID, THE AMERICANS COMMITTED THEM.

MORE NEWS BLACKOUT ON THE WESTERN FRONT. THE CANADIAN FIRST ARMY HAS
TAKEN IMMERICH AND PUSHED ON PAST. A NUMBER OF OTHER TOWNS IN THE AREA HAVE

MEETS ANOTHER AB. S GRIEFITHSX OF 15 MESS MET ONE OF HIS BROTHERS ON THE Q.E. IN COLOMBO. NOW HE HAS BUMPED INTO ANOTHER ONE, ALBERT E. GRIFFITHS, SEVING IN THE DEPOT SHIP, H.M.S. RESOURCE AT MANUS. THIS BROTHER HAS 26 YEARS AT SEA AND HAS BEEN TORPEDOED FOUR TIMES. GRIFFITHS SAYS HE HASN'T RUN OUR OF BROTHERS YER. HE HOPES TO MEET ANOTHER ONE IN THE PHILLUPINES.

WORLD NEWS FLASHES.....WE LISTENED TO A JAPANESE NEWS COMMENTATOR BROADCAST-ING FROM SHANGHAI AT 1130 TODAY, AND HIS ACCOUNT OF THE BATTLE AT OKINAWA WAS REALLY SOMETHING. ACCORDING TO HIM, THE JAPS HAVE SUNK \$46 SURFACE CRAFT OG THE U.S.NAVY, WHICH HAS MANAGED TO GET 6000 TROOPS ASHORE AGAINST "FIERCE RESISTANCE."

ADMIRAL NIMITZ' COMMUNIQUEN YOU WILL REDALL, SAID THAT 100,000 YANKS HAD GONE ASHORE. TODAY HE ANNOUNCED THAT THEY HAVE CUT THE ISLAND IN HALF AND TAKEN A THIRD AIRFIELD, WHIDH WILL SOON BE IN USE. 14 SURCIDE BOATS, CLAIMED TO BE A NEW JAPANESE WEAPON, WERE CAPTURED. MORE TROOPS AND SUPPLIES ARE POURING SHORE.

THE MMERICAN THIRD ARMY HAS MOVED UP TO A POSITION 120 MILES FROM BERLIN. FOREIGN SLAVE WORKERS ARE FLEEING THE REICH, TO SEEK SENCTUARY BEHING THE

BRITISH AND AMERICAN LINES.

GERMAN U-BOATS WERE ACTIVE IN MARCH, BUT RECENT RAIDS HAVE SLOWED THEM DOWN, ONE OF THE HEAVIEST HAS BEEN MEAINST DANZIG, WHICH, SINCE FALLING TO OUR FORCES, IS A SEVERE KOSS TO THE UNDERSEA FORCES.

ON MONDAY, THOUBANDS OF ROYAL AIR FORCE BOMBERS STRUCK AT HAMBURG, DROP-PONG 11-TON BOMBS. THIS CITY WAS VIRTUALLY LEVELLEDTWO YEARS AGO, AND THE

THIS IS THE CAPITAL OF EAST PRUSSIAM AND IS LOCATED ABOUT 90 MILES NORTH-EAST OF BERLIN. 27,000 NAZIS TROOPS WERE CAPTURED WHEN THE CITY FELL. THE DIPLOMATIC THEATRE TWENTY OF THE UNITED NATIONS HAVE RESUMED FRIENDLY RELATIONS WITH ARGENTINA, WHICH RECENTLY DECLARED WAR ON GERMANY AND JAPAN. SHE WAS THE LAST COUNTRY TO GET ON THE BAND-WAGON. THE CANINE THEATRE PETTY OFFICER MASCOT "CORDITE", WRCNS, SEEMS TO BE GOING HIGH-HAT SINCE HER MATED DEPARTED AND SHE ASSUMED SUPRÈME COMMAND IN THIS THEATRE. SHE IS NOW SHOWING SIGNS OF BECOMING AN UPPER-DECK DOG. LATEST INDIC-ATIONS WAS REVEALED YESTERDAY BY THE GUNNERY OFFICER WHO CALLED AT THE CAPTEIN DEA CABIN TO FIND "CORDITE" GRACEFULLY ENSCONCED ON THE CAPTAIN'S BUNKS FINALEX THAT'S ALL FOR TODAY. AS THE NEGRO MAMMY SAID, WHO HAD CHILDREN NAMED EENIE, MEENIE, MINIE AND GEORGE: "THERE AIN'T NO MO'".

F.D.R. WAS & GREAT "NAVY MAN". IN THE LAST WAR HE WAS THE UNITED STATE'S SECRETARY OF THE NAVY AND HE IS CREDITED WITH MUCH OF THE SUCCESS OF THE U.S. BUILDINGUP ITS PRESENT POWERFUL FLEET OF 1150 COMBAT WARSHUPS AND 3,200,000MEN

HIS UNTIMELY DEATH RAISES THE QUESTION: WHAT LINE WILL HIS SUCCESSOR TAKE? PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT WAS A GREAT FRIEND OF OURS. LONG BEFORE THE U.S. ACTUALLY DEGLARED WAR. HE WAS PROVIDING SUPPLIES. SHIPS. PLANES AND TANKS VIA LEND-LEASE. YOU REMEMBER HIS PRONCUNCEMENT: "ALL AID SHORT OF MAR! YOU ALSO REMEMBER HIS KINGSTON STATEMENT TO THE EFFECT THAT THE U.S. WOULD STAND OF CANADA IF SHE WERE EVEN THE ATEMED THE WAR. HE WAT IF IED THE TRANSFER OF SECOND AGE DESTROYERS TO THE BRITISH OF WHICH CANADA GOT 7), AND THESE VETERANS WERE PUT AT OUR DISPOSAL WHEN THEY WERE SORELY NEEDED.

IN POLITICS, PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT FOLLOWED A RATHER CURIOUS LINE. ALTHOUGH HE CAME FROM A WEALTHY FAMBLY, AND WAS EDUCATED AT GROTON AND HARVARD, HE
WAS KNOWN AS "THE WORKING MANIS FRIEND", AND DURING THE GREAT DEPRESSION,
INTRODUCED MANY BULLS AND WORKS PROGRAMMES (CCC, WPA, ETC) WHICH PROVIDED
RELIEF FOR THE LABORING CLASS. EVEN IN THOSE DAYS THEY QUIPPED THAT N.R.A.

MEANT "NOMINATE ROOSEVELT AGAIN" .

HE WAS ALSO A CHAMPION OF THE COLORED MAN'S CAUSE AND SOUGHT TO IMPROVE THEIR LOT, THIS WAS EVIDENT IN THE ATLANTIC CHARTER, WHICH HE SIGNED OFF ARGENTIA, NEWFOUNDLAND, WITH WINSTON CHURCHIKL IN THE SUMMER OF 1941, AND IN WHICH FREEDOM AND DIGNITY OF MAN "REGARDLESS OF RACE, COLOR OR CREED", WAS CHAMPHONED.

COMPARATIVELY LITTLE IS KNOWN ABOUT HIS SUCCESSOR, HARRY TRUMAN. HE WAS A SMALL-TOWN COUNTRY POLITICIAN, USED AS A FIGUREHEAD BY "BOSS" PENDERGRAST, WHOSE REPUTATION WAS NONE TOO SAVORY, BEFORE BEING SENT TO WASHINGTON AS A SENATOR. IN RECENT YEARS HE HAS DONE GOOD WORK THERE AS THE HEAD OF AN INVESTIGATING COMMITTEE WHICH SOUGHT TO CHECK WASTE IN PUBLIC FUNDS. HE ACTUALLY RECEIVED THE DEMOCRATIC NOMINATION FOR VICE-PRESIDENT AS A SORT OF ALTERNATIVE WHEN HENRY WALLACE WAS DEFEATED AND NO OTHER STRONG CANDIDATE WAS PRODUCED.

IT IS HIGHLY PROBABLE THAT HARRY TRUMAN WILL CARRY ON WITH THE SAME PRINCIPLES WHICH WERE LASD DOWN BY THE LATE PRESIDENT, WITH WHOM HE HAD WORKED AND WHOM HE ADMIRED, AND CALLED A CLOSE FRIEND. BUT THERE CAN BE NO GAINSAYING THE GREAT LOSS THAT HAS BEFALLEN NOT ONLY THE UNITED STATED, BUT THE UNITED NATIONS. IT FALLS TO FEW MEN TO BECOME A LEGEND IN THEIR TIME; PRES.
