2. As these two small Stations are situate within 75 yards of one another and they are both in the same state, a report is made upon them together.

(A) In accordance with previous instructions operations at these Stations were discontinued previous to the cessation of hostilities and all Radar and Signals equipment surveyed at H.M.C. Dockyard. All other Naval stores and equipment were similarly surveyed.

(B) Attached is a measured drawing of each of these buildings, as prepared by the Office of the Staff Officer Maintenance, H.M.C. Dockyard, both dated 1st June, 1945. Each station consists of one small building only, as shown in the respective plans.

(C) All Naval personnel have been withdrawn from these stations. The windows have been boarded up, the doors locked, and the keys are now being handed to the Staff Officer Maintenance, H.M.C. Dockyard, Halifax, N.S.

(D) Power: The power formerly supplied by the Nova Scotia Light & Power Co. Ltd. has been disconnected.

Water: Neither station had any water supply.

Telephone services:- The telephones to each station were Command lines, installed by the Army Signals. These have been removed.

Leases: There are no leases. Both stations are situate on land which is not suitable for agriculture or industry, and has never been granted away by the Crown. It is therefore Provincial Government land, and is contiguous to a large block of National Defence Department property lying to the North of it.

(E) The Administrative Authority, namely Commander of the Port, will not be continued, and it is suggested that further memoranda upon these stations should be directed to the Commander in Chief, Canadian Northwest Atlantic, with copy to the Commodore Superintendent.

Halifax, N. S. - Hill 100 - Radar for C. M.

The above named shore facility will not be required in Phase II, and no continuing need is seen for it in the post-war period.

2. The property may therefore be disposed of and/or the lease terminated, as soon as the operational activities there have been shut down, and personnel and special equipment have been withdrawn.

3. Staff Minute 299-11 refers.

4. The land here is understood to be the property of the Province of Nova Scotia. The Naval Service moved in, seemingly without any formal lease, and in 1940 erected a one-room frame building.

5. A few further details may be obtained if required from D. of P.

6. It is believed that the Army may be interested in acquiring this property.
