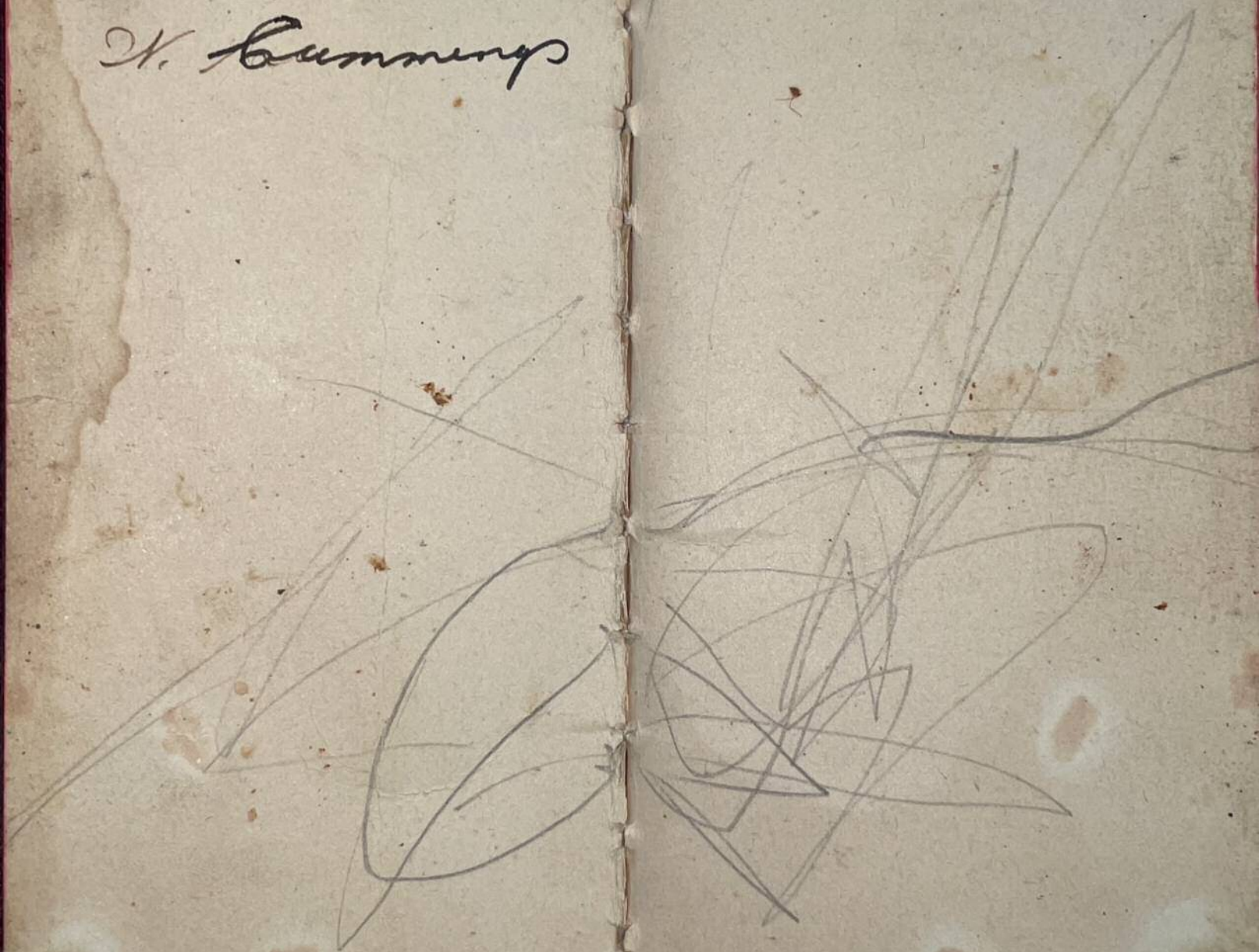

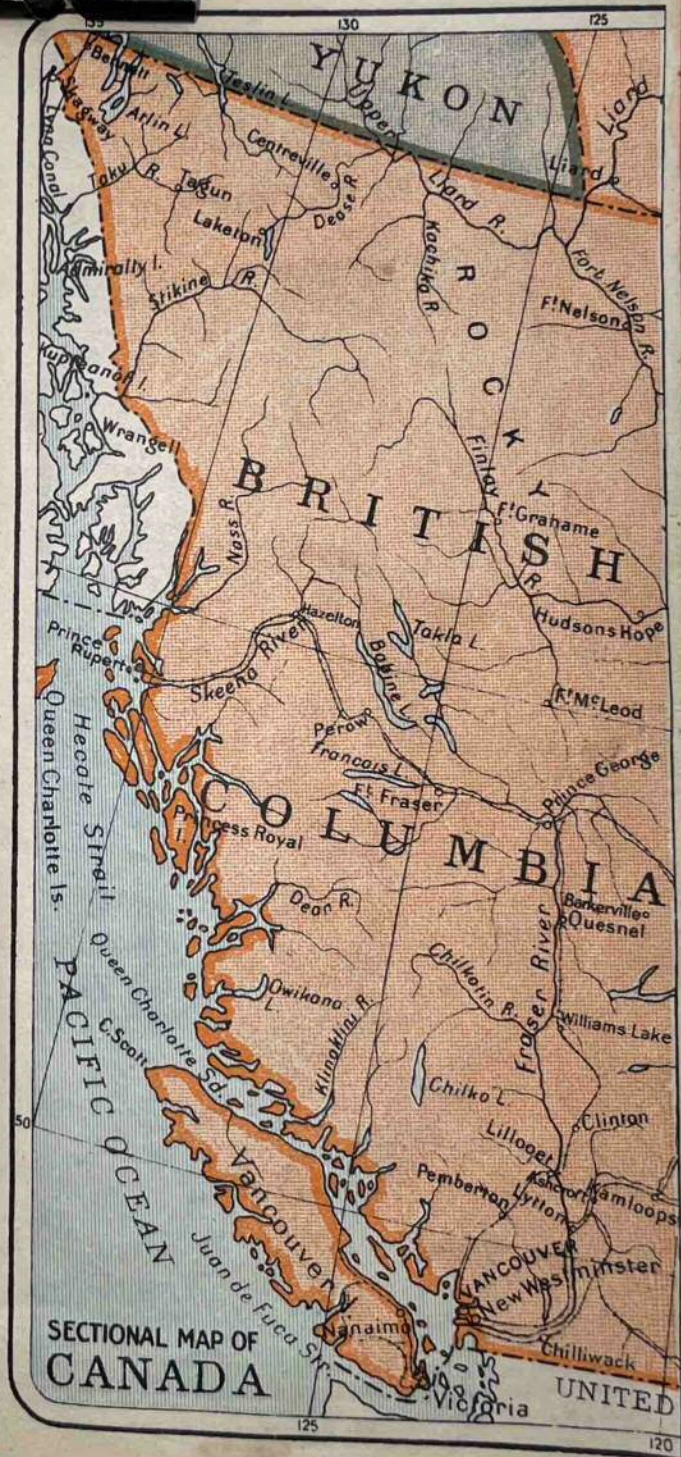

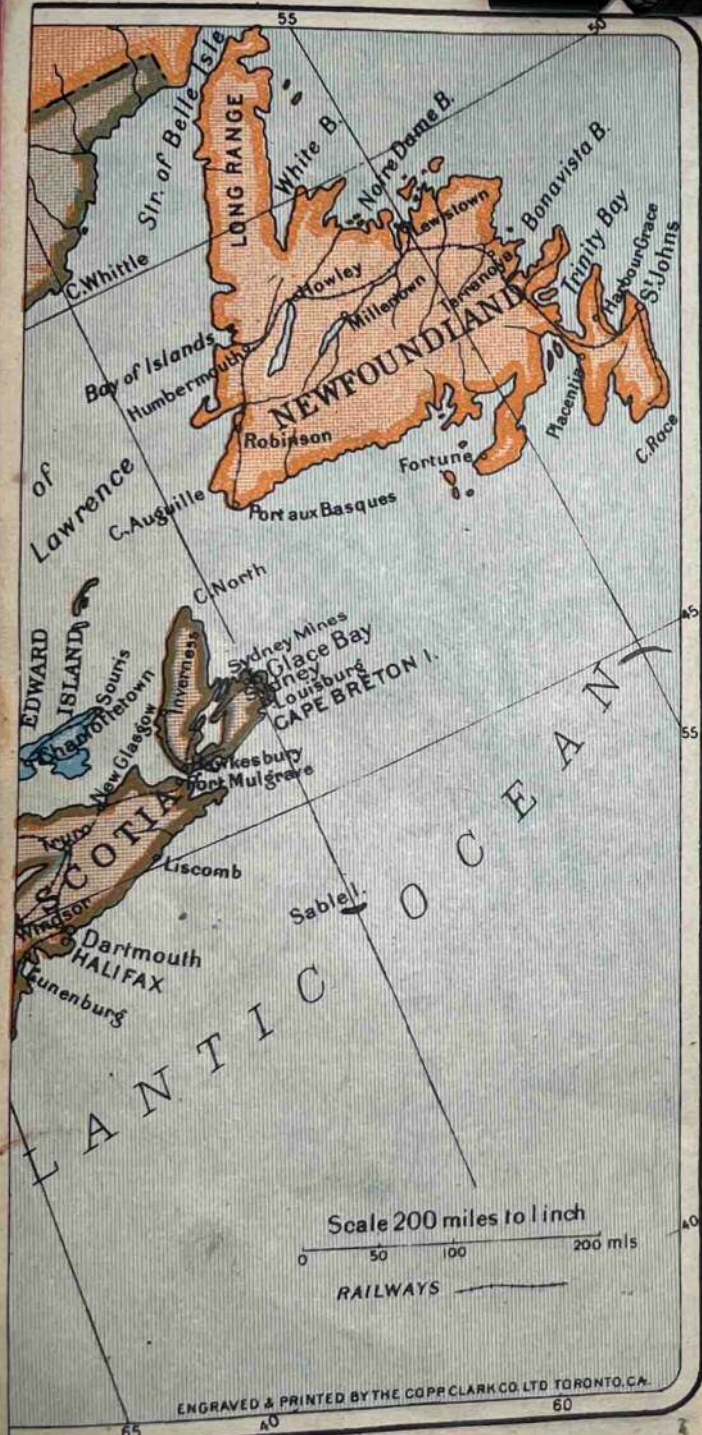

The oz. Troy and Apothecaries' = 1.09714 oz. Avoirdupois; but the lb. Troy and lb. Apothecaries', only = 0.82286 lb. Avoirdupois; while 175 lb. Troy and Apothecaries' = 144 lb. Avoirdupois.
