THIS IS TO CERTIFY that according to official information Stanley Norman Rice, Stoker 2nd Class, Official Number V-31943, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, is missing, presumed killed in action to date the 6th of February, 1943, when the ship in which he was serving was sunk by enemy action overseas.

Dear Mrs. Rice:

I deeply regret that I must confirm the telegram of the 11th of February, 1943, from the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services informing you that your son, Stanley Norman Rice, Stoker 2nd Class, Official Number V.31943, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, is missing, presumed killed in action.

I regret that I have no further information at present other than a report from Overseas that your son is missing, presumed killed when the ship in which he was serving was sunk by enemy action. I can assure you, however, that immediately further details are available you will be informed.

It is for the public interest that the name of the ship and the fact that she has been lost should not find its way to the enemy until such time as it is decided to publish this information in a Naval Casualty List. For this reason it is requested that you will regard as confidential anything beyond the fact of your son's death on war service until such time as an official announcement is made.

Please allow me to express sincere sympathy with you in your bereavement on behalf of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, the Chief of Naval Staff, and the Officers and men of the Royal Canadian Navy, the high traditions of which your son has helped to maintain.
