wing scarlett fever at Esquimaux

B. C. on June 2nd. 1917. and as
above stated I re-enlisted on July
16th 1917. I was sent to Halifax
and then to various stations. I was
one of the crew of H. M. Canadian
trawler Givendy which ship left Halifax
Canada for Esquimaux and was
discharged there on June 3rd 1919.
I am hoping for an early
reply.
