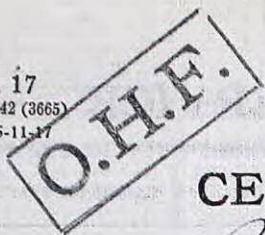

Dear Mrs. Thompson:

It is with deepest regret that I must confirm the telegram of the 17th of April, 1945, from the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, informing you that your son, Ronald Ewing Dunlop, Motor Mechanic, Official Number V-57236, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, has been killed in action.

For security reasons, the only information which may be released at this time is that your son's death was due to enemy action.

As you are aware, his body was recovered and, in accordance with your wishes, is being sent, at public expense, to Calgary, Alta. You will be informed of the date and time of arrival by the Commanding Officer, H.M.C.S. "TECUMSEH", Calgary, who will be pleased to assist you in making any necessary arrangements for the funeral.



It is requested that you will regard the name of the ship in which he was serving, together with the fact that she has been in contact with the enemy, as secret until an official announcement is made.

Please allow me to express sincere sympathy with you in your bereavement on behalf of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, the Chief of the Naval Staff, and the Officers and men of the Royal Canadian Navy, the high traditions of which your son has helped to maintain.
