(a) To serve from the date thereof for ~~three consecutive years~~ ^{duration of hostilities}, being subject to the provisions of the Naval Service Act, and of the Regulations made in pursuance thereof for the government of the Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, and to the customs and usages of His Majesty's Canadian Naval Service.
