Garrett is a big, rugged, red-haired fellow (6'-197 lb) with a healthy, clean-cut appearance. His manner is agreeable, somewhat shy, and decidedly boyish. His deportment during the interview was that of a person who is energetic but stable and good-tempered. He is in excellent health, and is unmarried.

Hockey is Garrett's major sport. He has played professionally for the New York Ranger's team (1942-43) and for a number of teams in Toronto and Sudbury. He is also keen about tennis. His hobby is chess, and he says he has become quite fond of it in recent months. Reading interests him moderately. He states that he likes the books of Vat. When he leaves the Navy, Garrett intends to play professional hockey during the winter and sell insurance during the remainder of the year. He believes that the combination of these two activities will guarantee him a successful future.

Garrett is a rating with superior learning ability (M score 176). He expresses himself moderately well in a mild, thin voice. He is resourceful, self-confident, and far-sighted. His personality is friendly, and he seems to be popular with his shipmates. Apparently he is able to take over the direction of group activity with assurance. Garrett undoubtedly has many officer-like qualities, but at present his general estimate is

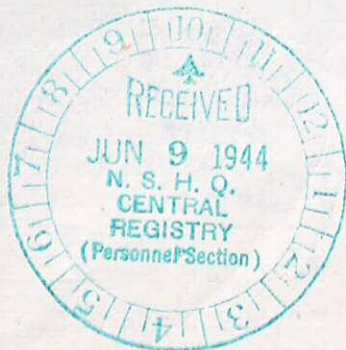

Dear Mr. Garrett:

It is with deepest regret that I must confirm the telegram of the 29th of November, 1944, from the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, informing you that your son, Dudley Morine Garrett, Able Seaman, Official Number V-65928, Royal Canadian Naval Volunteer Reserve, has been killed on active service.

The only information that can be given at this time is that your son was killed when the ship in which he was serving was lost. Please be assured, however, that as soon as further particulars can be released, you will be informed.

It is requested that, for security reasons you regard the name of the ship in which your son was serving, as confidential until such time as an official announcement is made.

Please allow me at this time to express sincere sympathy with you in your bereavement on behalf of the Minister of National Defence for Naval Services, the Chief of the Naval Staff, and the officers and men of the Royal Canadian Navy, the high traditions of which your son has helped to maintain.

Dear Mr. Garrett:

Further to my letter of the 7th of December, 1944, the Department is now able to release additional information regarding the loss of your son's ship and I am accordingly passing on the following particulars which will, no doubt, be of interest to you.

H.M.C.S. "SHAWINIGAN" sailed from Sydney, N.S., on the 24th of November, 1944, to escort a merchant ship to Port Aux Basques, Newfoundland, and arrived off Port Aux Basques that night. In accordance with orders she was then to carry out a patrol in the area for the duration of the night, after which she was to meet the same merchant ship the next morning and return with her to Sydney.

The merchant ship arrived in Sydney unescorted on the night of the 25th of November and after it was ascertained that "SHAWINIGAN" had not appeared at the designated rendezvous to provide escort as instructed, searches were instituted and "SHAWINIGAN" was discovered to be missing.

It was the opinion of the Department at the time that the ship had been torpedoed by an enemy submarine during the night of the 24th/25th of November, 1944, as submarines were known to be operating in that area; and this has since been confirmed from German evidence. Although no survivors were found, a few bodies were recovered by later searches, due to tidal movements, some distance from the area in which "SHAWINIGAN" was known to be operating. As a result, the position of the sinking can not be exactly ascertained, although from German evidence and the Department's computation, it is estimated to be in the vicinity of the three mile limit off Channel Head, near Port Aux Basques, Newfoundland.
